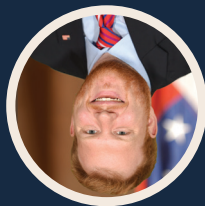

# Supporting Public Safety

**Josh supports bills that defend law enforcement as they keep our communities safe.**

-  Designate certain offenses against emergency medical services personnel, firefighters, and law enforcement officers as hate crimes. (A.3417)
-  Make the crime of resisting arrest; provide that a second violation within 5 years shall be a class E felony. (A.3584)
-  Make exposing a first responder or correction officer to fentanyl, a fentanyl derivative, or an opiate containing fentanyl or a fentanyl derivative in the definition of the offense of assault in the first degree. (A.4085)
-  Discourage the unlawful discharge of a loaded firearm toward any police officer, firefighter, corrections officer, peace officer, or emergency medical services personnel. (A.4522)
-  Establish a program for the care of retired law enforcement dogs to cover the cost of veterinary care for the remainder of their lifetime. (A.4975)
-  Protect the well-being of men and women in uniform by increasing the penalties for menacing a police officer or peace officer. (A.6578 of 2022; A.6338 of 2023)
