Assemblymember Lunsford: Fighting for Families



Providing economic relief to working families

- Provides \$2.2 billion in tax rebates for eligible homeowners
- Secures the lowest tax rate in 70 years for our families through middle class tax cuts
- Expands the Child Tax Credit and the Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)
- Suspends the state gas tax, saving motorists \$585 million

Investing in education and child care

- Invests nearly \$3 billion more in child care
- Provides \$343 million in grants to child care providers to help raise wages and control costs
- Allocates \$1.1 billion to expand Universal Pre-K across the state
- Invests \$52.5 billion in total school aid
- Provides an **11% increase** in special education provider rates
- Includes a tax exemption for all state loan forgiveness programs

Assemblymember Lunsford helped pass a state budget that supports New Yorkers struggling with rising inflation, invests in education, health care and environmental preservation, and makes commonsense reforms.

Fighting against climate change

- Creates a \$4.2 billion Environmental Bond to help local governments improve drinking water quality, mitigate flooding and harden their infrastructure to climate change
- Protects our freshwater wetlands
- Expands the Brownfield Cleanup program
- Provides \$400 million to the Environmental Protection Fund

Funding health care

- Improves access to telehealth services
- Adds \$904 million to Medicaid and \$120 million to public health programs
- Creates bonuses of up to \$3,000 to full-time health and mental hygiene frontline workers
- Gives a long overdue cost-of-living raise to mental hygiene workers in hospitals and group homes

Making government work

- Creates a Department of Veterans Affairs to help streamline access to resources for our veterans
- Enhances the Hire-A-Vet tax credit to encourage businesses to hire more veterans
- Creates a database of economic development projects to track how the government is spending tax revenue
- Fulfills the state's responsibility to fund local governments and lets local tax dollars stay local
