Helping our families make ends meet

- ✓ Reduced tax burdens for **more than 75%** of New Yorkers*
- ✓ Expanded the Empire State Child Tax Credit, providing **up to \$1,000** per child under the age of four, and **\$500** for children ages 4-16, as well as passed the Working Families Tax Credit*
- ✓ Expanded the universal school meals program, offering all students free breakfast and lunch*
- ✓ Increased child care subsidies and voted to fund a substitute child care provider network*
- ✓ Eliminated New York's Unemployment Trust Fund debt, raising weekly payments from \$504 to \$869*
- ✓ Passed the "100-foot rule" to end subsidies for new gas lines to help lower utility costs (A.8888)

Making our neighborhoods more secure

- ✓ Strengthened cybersecurity laws, requiring municipal governments to report incidents to the Division of Homeland Security (Ch. 177 of 2025)
- ✓ Supported the establishment of a body-worn camera program in the Department of Corrections and Community Supervision (A.8871)
- ✓ Secured **\$8 million** for the Daniel's Law Pilot Program to reform crisis response*
- ✓ Established the Office of Gun Violence Prevention & reformed Discovery laws while protecting due process*
- ✓ Passed Shield Law 2.0 to protect abortion and gender-affirming health care (A.5480-C)
- ✓ Reformed discovery law addressing loopholes that caused case dismissals*
