## Budget Extended Again and Again

**NYS BUDGET EXTENDED FOR TENTH TIME, HAWLEY SEES DELAYS HARMING LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICTS**

### **Letter from the office of Assemblyman Steve Hawley,**

As you may have seen, Albany has now passed its ninth and 10th budget extenders. While that might sound like business as usual, the reality is these delays are creating real challenges for our local schools right here in Genesee, Monroe and Orleans counties.

Right now, school districts are working to finalize their budgets for the upcoming year, budgets that you'll be voting on in just a few weeks. Without a finalized state budget, they're being forced to make important decisions without knowing how much funding they can actually count on. That means uncertainty around staffing, classroom resources and student programs.

Steve has been hearing directly from school leaders across our region, and the frustration is clear. Every time Albany kicks the can down the road, it makes it harder for our schools to plan responsibly and deliver for students and taxpayers alike.

Every time Albany passes another extender, local schools are left in the dust to wonder if they'll be able to do their jobs because the Majority and governor can't. School districts are trying to put together budgets for the next school year right now, and they need real numbers, not guesses, so they can present something responsible to their communities.

Steve believes it's time to get the job done. Our schools and the families they serve deserve certainty, not continued delays. He will keep pushing for a final budget so our communities can move forward with confidence.
