FREE KIDNEY SCREENING FAQ'S:

Who should be screened? What will happen at a kidney screening program?

You should attend a screening if you are 18 years or older and have one of the following risk factors:

- Diabetes
- High Blood Pressure

 Family history of Diabetes/ High Blood Pressure/Kidney Disease

What will happen at a kidney screening program?

- 1. Complete paperwork on your health/family members' health history.
- 2. Blood Pressure and Body Mass Index tests.
- 3. Urine tests for signs of protein or blood (early indicators of kidney disease).
- 4. Finger stick for Glucose Testing (fasting or non-fasting).
- 5. Each Participant will speak with a medical professional at the completion of testing.
- 6. Check out: Each participant is given educational materials to take home. Preliminary information includes, blood pressure and glucose numbers, and urine test results, given by medical professionals on site.
