Protect yourself and your loved ones from possible identity theft by ensuring that your private and confidential documents are disposed of properly and safely.

What should be shredded?

"Shredded materials"
are confidential documents which include anything with account or social security numbers, bank or medical statements, tax documents, etc.

What should not be shredded?

"Non-shredded materials"
should be recycled in your recycling tote, NOT brought to the Community Shredding Event. Non-shredded material includes: any non-confidential papers, including junk mail, envelopes, and magazines.
