Last year, there were over 1,000 motor vehicle crashes along West Seneca roadways, including 10 people hit while cycling and 20 people hit while walking. From 2018-2024, crashes claimed the lives of 11 people and left 300 others injured.*

Assemblyman Burke, in partnership with the Town of West Seneca, is working with GObike to gather feedback that will inform recommendations for transportation safety improvements across West Seneca.
