Last year, there were over 700 motor vehicle crashes along Orchard Park roadways, including a person hit while cycling and 8 people hit while walking. From 2018-2024, crashes claimed the lives of 10 people and left 86 others injured.*

Assemblyman Burke, in partnership with the Village of Orchard Park, is working with GObike to gather feedback that will inform recommendations for transportation safety improvements across Orchard Park.
