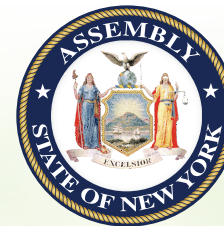

New York’s Paid Family Leave program

Who is eligible?

- ✓ Full-time employees with a regular schedule of at least 20 hours per week are eligible after 26 weeks of consecutive employment
- ✓ Part-time employees working less than 20 hours per week are eligible after working 175 days, which do not need to be consecutive
- ✓ Funded entirely by employees through a payroll deduction of 0.126% – currently no more than \$1.64 per week

When can Paid Family Leave be used?

- ✓ Parents during the first 12 months after the birth, adoption, or fostering of a child
- ✓ Family members caring for a sick relative
- ✓ Employees whose spouse, domestic partner, child, or parent is on active military duty abroad or will soon be deployed

Benefits Schedule

Year	Weeks Available	Max. % of weekly wage*
2018	8	50%
2019	10	55%
2020	10	60%
2021	12	67%

*Or New York State average weekly wage – whichever is less
