- **Pass the Domestic Violence Prevention Act:**

Brittany's Law: named after a young girl and her mother who were murdered by a convicted violent felon they had unknowingly welcomed into their lives, this act would create a statewide public registry of convicted violent felons similar to the state's existing sex offender database. Violent felons have a very high recidivism rate, so knowing someone has a violent past is lifesaving information Mike Norris believes the public should know.
