Apprenticeship Program Funding

With his first state budget, Assemblyman Angelo J. Morinello was able to address several of our community's needs. The legalization of ride-sharing for western New York, \$25.2 billion in school funding, fair pay for direct-care workers, and funding for apprenticeship programs across the state are all major victories for the residents of the 145th Assembly District.

Other Budget Accomplishments:

- This year's budget will provide **\$2.5** billion for clean water infrastructure projects and an additional \$75 million for New York residents to install, replace, or upgrade septic systems.
- CHIPS funding will total \$438.1 million plus an additional \$65 million for extreme winter recovery and \$100 million for the paving of New York's roads.
- The state budget also sets aside **\$95.6** million in aid for libraries across the state.
- Secured \$200 million to fight New York's heroin and opioid epidemic, a
 \$30 million increase from last year's budget
