Assemblymember McMahon is **protecting** our **environment**

To promote environmental conservation in Western New York, Karen:

- ✓ Co-sponsored the New York State Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act, which would **reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 85% by 2050** and create good-paying green energy jobs (Ch. 106 of 2019)
