- Sponsored and passed the Equal Pay Law, which affirms that wage discrimination is illegal in New York and ensures that every employee is paid what they deserve based on the work that they do (Ch. 93 of 2019)
- Passed a comprehensive paid sick leave and employee benefits bill for those under a mandatory or precautionary quarantine order due to COVID-19 (Ch. 25 of 2020)

- Passed a law that provides death benefits to families of frontline workers who lost their lives to the COVID-19 pandemic (Ch. 89 of 2020)
