NEW YORK'S PUSH FOR GREEN ENERGY CAUSES SIGNIFICANT FINANCIAL HURDLES FOR MIDDLE-CLASS FAMILIES

- ✓ The costs associated with electrification, such as upgrading appliances, **MAY COST SOME HOMEOWNERS IN EXCESS OF \$46,200!**²
- ✓ For new construction, **COSTS FOR ELECTRIFICATION ARE ESTIMATED TO RANGE FROM \$12,000 TO \$23,000**, accounting for an air source heat pump, a full range of appliances, labor and infrastructure necessities.¹
- ✓ **ROLLING BLACKOUTS CAN AND WILL OCCUR** during arctic blasts when electricity demands exceed supply.³

- ✓ Climate zealots have targeted wood and coal-fired pizza ovens, destroying family businesses in the process.⁶
- ✓ We must consider green mandates because they carry little regard for energy security, technological readiness or cost implications.⁷
- ✓ Electric appliances and induction cooktops are expensive to purchase and come with increased electricity costs in order to use them.⁸
- ✓ Rushed implementation of bans and mandates disregards the practicality and infrastructure challenges that lie ahead.⁹
