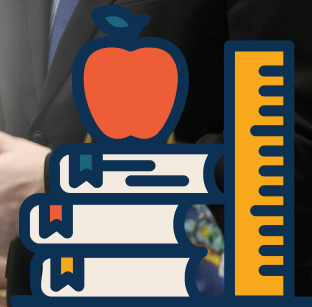

This is why I support:

- ✓ The EmpowerED Act would let students take classes and learn from teachers outside their home district—especially in rural areas—by expanding BOCES partnerships to improve education quality, offer more choices, and reduce costs for the state. (A.2009)
- ✓ The Learning for Work Act would create a high school youth apprenticeship program, a specialized career diploma, and tax incentives for participating employers to better prepare students for good-paying jobs after graduation while reducing student debt. (A.2118)
- ✓ This proposal would allow school districts to permanently opt out of New York's zero-emission school bus mandate if they face challenges like power shortages, high costs, long routes, or cold-weather performance issues. (A.2005)
