Whether it's a parent walking their child to school, a nurse ending a late shift, or a neighbor calling for help, safety isn't a political issue. It's personal. These six bills would close dangerous loopholes and give law enforcement the tools they actually need to protect you.

Assemblyman Molitor's Public Safety Priorities Would:

Grant Judges More Discretion to Set Bail

Adds to the list of bail eligible offenses and gives judges the framework to set bail for repeat offenders. (A.6957)

Protect Police and Public Servants

We should increase penalties against people who spit on or hit our police officers, EMS personnel, firefighters, nurses, and other important public servants.

(A.6926)

Provide Maximum Penalty for Public Servant Death

When a police officer, peace officer, first responder, or correction officer is murdered, the ONLY sentence must be life without parole. (A.1480)

Protect our Children

We should have increased penalties against people who abuse children and there should be escalating punishment for those who do so repeatedly. (A.3512)

Increase Evidence in Criminal Trials

A defendant's prior crimes or bad acts should be more broadly admissible to prove specific elements like motive, intent, etc. (A.00053A)

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
