My Plan to Power the Economy and Cut the Red Tape Would:

LOWER ENERGY COSTS

- **PROTECT ENERGY CHOICE:** defend the right of consumers to choose the energy source that works best for their home or business. (A.653)
- **REQUIRE REAL COST REVIEWS:** demand a full cost-benefit analysis before Albany forces expensive energy mandates on taxpayers. (A.6260)
- **EXPOSE MANDATE COSTS:** require monthly reporting so the public sees the true price of state-mandated energy programs. (A.6152A)
- **CUT THE GAS TAX:** eliminate the state sales tax on gas for two years to deliver relief for commuters, workers and local employers. (A.7417)

INCREASE QUALITY JOBS

- **FIRST EMPLOYEE TAX CREDIT:** help small businesses hire their first permanent payroll employee and take the next step toward growth. (A.4454)
- **REPEAL BURDENSOME REGULATIONS:** repeal laws like the Scaffold Law that increase costs for businesses. (A.9633)
- **REGULATORY NOTICE:** require businesses to receive notice of new rules, an important tool to help businesses when regulations are applied unfairly. (A.9634)
- **SMALL BUSINESS TAX RELIEF:** provide tax credits that let businesses reinvest in workers, equipment and expansion. (A.3221)
