NOTICE OF HEARING

<u>SUBJECT</u>: Supports for foster parents and relative and non-relative caretakers

<u>PURPOSE</u>: To examine the impact of the State budget on supports for foster parents and caretakers of children removed from their homes

Hearing Room C, Legislative Office Building Albany, NY Thursday, December 14th 11:00 a.m.

Caregivers of children removed from the home may be foster parents or non-foster parents, and relatives or non-relatives. Regardless of the situation it is critical that such caregivers have adequate support to ensure the safety and well-being of the children they are caring for. This support comes in many forms including foster care subsidies, kinship programs and services such as counseling, respite and legal assistance. This hearing is intended to examine the adequacy of supports for caregivers in the context of the State budget.

Persons wishing to present pertinent testimony to the Committees at the above hearing should complete and return the enclosed reply form at least twenty-four hours prior to the commencement of the hearing. It is important that the reply form be fully completed and returned so that persons may be notified in the event of emergency postponement or cancellation.

Oral testimony will be limited to 10 minutes. In preparing the order of witnesses, the Committees will attempt to accommodate individual requests to speak at particular times in view of special circumstances. These requests should be made on the attached reply form or communicated to Committee staff as early as possible. In the absence of a request, witnesses will be scheduled in the order in which reply forms are postmarked.

Ten (10) copies of any prepared testimony should be submitted at the hearing registration desk.

In order to further publicize these hearings, please inform interested parties and organizations of the Committees' interest in hearing testimony from all sources.

In order to meet the needs of those who may have a disability, the New York State Senate and Assembly have made their facilities and services available to all individuals with disabilities. For individuals with disabilities, accommodations will be provided, upon reasonable request, to afford such individuals access and admission to Senate and Assembly facilities and activities.
