Assemblymember Epstein, Chair Krueger, and Chair Weinstein:

At the 2/14 budget hearing Assemblymember Epstein raised the need for more composting. Commissioner Seggos mentioned Executive Order 22. I am adding some additional information below in respect to our next steps for composting by agencies. Further, I have included details about our upcoming Green New York Council meeting. Thank you for your question and interest in this topic and we look forward to working with you more to advance our sustainability and waste reduction goals.

Executive Order 22

<u>EO22</u> calls for every agency to reduce their waste 10% every five years starting from a FY 18/19 baseline. As part of this, each agency will have to create a waste reduction plan that includes a plan to divert their organic waste from landfills/incineration. This is due one year from when the plan template is issued by the GreenNY (GNY) Council.

Current Composting
