Dear Chairwoman Senator Liz Krueger, Chairwoman Assemblymember Helene E. Weinstein,
and Honorable Members of the Committee,

My name is Elaine Lamm, and I am a parent residing in Flushing, NY. I am writing to strongly
urge your full support and funding to deliver Universal Child Care to New York State.

I do not have children but have seen how the cost of childcare has impacted my neighborhood
and workplace. Many of my friends have been dealing with the difficult decision to move out of
the city, or leave the workforce. I have seen extremely talented women that want to continue to
work feel like they don't have a choice because childcare can be \$20,000-\$40,000 a year. A
workforce where moms are able to participate is a better workplace for everyone. It will also
bring additional taxable income to the city and state.

It is important also that we pay the child care educators a fair wage. They are the backbone of
making universal childcare work and we need to ensure they are fairly compensated and are
also not making impossible decisions for their own lives that lead to burn out. Childcare workers
are leaving to work in retail or other areas to get better pay and benefits.

I urge the full funding of a statewide 3K and Pre-K Guarantee, and 2- Care in New York City to
tackle the issue of Child Care Affordability.
